# **BASIC VILLAGE ORDINANCES**

1) Mowing grass onto Village streets is prohibited.

- 2) 2) All Village Parks close at 11:00pm, except Lions Lake is open 24 hours to fisherman. Liquor is allowed in Village Parks by permit only (issued by the Dwight Police department), with the exception of Lions Lake. Liquor is strictly prohibited at Lions Lake.
- Curfew for kids 16yrs. and under is 11pm, Sunday through Thursday, and Midnight on Friday & Saturday.
- It is unlawful for weeds and grass to be in excess of 6" tall. Failure to maintain the proper height can result in a fine, mowing fees and/or possibly a lien on your property.
- 5) Signs (garage sale, etc.) affixed to telephone poles and traffic devices are prohibited.
- 6) Dogs and cats must be on a leash when walking. No pets are allowed in any Village Park except for Lions Lake. All dogs must be on a leash within Lions Lake at all times.
- 7) Rollerblading is prohibited on East & West Main Streets, Rt. 47, Rt. 17 & Old Rt. 66. Through the rest of town, bladers must use the sidewalk when possible, and must always yield to traffic.
- 8) No bicycle riding is allowed on the sidewalks of East & West Main Street.
- 9) No semis are allowed to park on Village streets unless they are loading or unloading.
- 10) No parking on any Village street, December 1st to March 1st between 2:00am & 6:00am.
- 11) No parking on any Village street within 12 hours after a snowfall of 2" or more or until the snow has been removed by Public Works.
- 12) No parking in the downtown business district between 2:00am & 6:00 am at anytime.
- 13) Burning leaves, garbage or any other refuse, at anytime within the Village of Dwight is prohibited.

\*\*\*<u>The Village Public Services Complex/</u> <u>Village Hall hours</u> are from 8:00am to 4:30pm, Monday through Friday.

\*\*\*Public Works hours are from 7:00am to 4:00pm Monday through Friday.

# **\*\*\*VILLAGE BOARD MEETINGS**

are held on the 2nd and 4th Monday's of each month at 6:30pm., downstairs in the Board Room at the Public Services Complex.

**GARBAGE PICKUP:** Garbage pick up on the Southside of the tracks is on Wednesday, and pick up on the North side of the tracks is on Thursday. Toters must be placed at the street by 6:00 am on the day of collection. Please place the lid opening towards the street to avoid damage to your can. You will be supplied a 96 gallon toter for refuse and a 96 gal-Ion toter for recycling. Refuse is picked up weekly and recycling is picked up every other week. You are also allowed one large item a week for pickup. More details on garbage pick up and Recycling/ Holiday calendars may be obtained through the Village Hall.

**YARD WASTE:** must be in the paper biodegradable bags and at the <u>street</u> by 6am for pickup every <u>Monday</u> from April 1st—Nov 30th. No containers will be dumped and you are NOT allowed to dump yard waste out at Public Works.
