The Applicant is hereby notified that no plumbing permit shall be valid for a period of more than 18 months from the date of issuance, as set forth in Chapter 23, section 109 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Dwight. WHEN PLUMBING WORK IS READY TO BE INSPECTED, YOU MUST GIVE THE INSPECTOR 48 HOURS NOTIFICATION FOR INSPECTION AND THE BEFORE ALL WORK IS COVERED.
